Re: Amendment to Sporting and Technical Rules

1.1 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS - QUALIFYING

1.1.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Sporting & Technical Rule 4.12.1.3:**

- 4.12.1.3 **Session 2 - The Top Ten Shootout Part 1 (TTSO1) and Part 2 (TTSO2)** will be regarded as one (1) qualifying Session comprising of two parts (TTSO1) and (TTSO2) for those Drivers who achieve the top 10 places in the classification of Session 1 – Qualifying Part 1 (Q1) and Part 2 (Q2).
The procedure will commence as follows:
- 4.12.1.3.1 TTSO1 - Lower 50%: During TTSO1, all Cars in the Lower 50% as determined by the final classification of times from qualifying are to take part.
 - 4.12.1.3.2 TTSO2 - Upper 50%: During TTSO2 all Cars in the Upper 50% as determined by the final classification of times from qualifying are to take part.
 - 4.12.1.4 Should two (2) or more Drivers set identical times, priority will be given to the Driver who set the time first.
 - 4.12.1.5 Maximum time extension permitted is five (5) minutes per TTSO1 and TTSO2.
 - 4.12.1.6 Failure to comply with the Top Ten Shootout procedure may result in the Car being disqualified from the Top Ten Shootout.
 - 4.12.1.7 Article 4.9.1 will not apply to the fastest lap time recorded during the Top Ten Shootout.
 - 4.12.1.8 At the end of the Top Ten Shootout, the final classification of times achieved by each Car will be officially published.

1.2 PIT BAY MARKINGS

1.2.1 At this Event, note the following new **Sporting & Technical Rule 4.25.1.1.2:**

- 4.25.1.1.2 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, must be 600mm from prescribed line and parallel to the Pit Building upright.

1.3 WET WEATHER TYRES

1.3.1 At this Event, delete **Sporting & Technical Rule 6.16.1** and replace with the following:

- 6.16.1 A maximum of twenty-four (24) new wet weather tyres, purchased exclusively for the 2024 Bathurst 12HR from the nominated tyre supplier at the Event, must be marked/scanned for exclusive use on each Car during all practice Sessions, qualifying Sessions, and the race.
