ENDURANCE CUP POINTS

Further to Sporting Note #2, issued during the Repco Bathurst 12 Hours, the points for the 2024 Fanatec GT World Challenge Australia Endurance Cup are hereby confirmed by the Sporting Board.

From the cars and drivers marked as eligible for points for the Fanatec GT World Challenge Australia Endurance Cup on the official entry list for the Repco Bathurst 12 Hours, only those teams and drivers which have confirmed their entry into the Endurance Cup have been retained.

Points have been given in accordance with the standard allocation (25-18-15-12-10-8- 6-4-2-1), to the eligible teams and drivers, based on the Pro, Pro-Am and Silver categories of the Repco Bathurst 12 Hours, using the 75% classification criteria of the 2024 Fanatec GT World Challenge Australia Sporting Regulations. No points have been given to the Qualifying results.
