SPORTING NOTE - FANATEC GT WORLD CHALLENGE AUSTRALIA - ENDURANCE CUP

The Repco Bathurst 12 Hours is a round of the 2024 Fanatec GT World Challenge Australia Endurance Cup.

The Sporting and Technical regulations for the Event are those of the Repco Bathurst 12 Hours.

All eligible cars will be indicated on the final entry list with an asterisk and will be eligible for the Fanatec GT World Challenge Australia Endurance Cup.

Points will be given in accordance with the standard allocation (25-18-15-12-10-8- 6-4-2-1), to the eligible cars in the Pro, Pro-Am and Silver categories. No points will be given after Qualifying.

Any eligible cars which finish on the podiums for the Repco Bathurst 12 Hours podiums will additionally be presented with a Fanatec GT World Challenge Australia trophy.

The Fanatec GT World Challenge global manufacturer points will be based on the overall results of the race, based on all FIA GT3 cars entered in the Pro, Pro-Am and Silver categories.
